### ***BSI Labor & Scheduling has a Host of New Features***

Employees can now Clock In and Clock Out just by entering their password and clicking a button in the Labor & Scheduling time clock. Times are stored, along with employee information, and used to monitor labor costs and create a payroll. Payroll, time sheets, and employee information can be exported and imported in a variety of formats. A very powerful private key encryption is available. New import wizards import information from any third party device that can produce a regular text file, including TEC R4 timecard information.

Labor & Scheduling is now interfaced with POS Store & Forward to collect periodic sales information. TEC customers also get tip information that comes from the TEC register, allowing them to automatically make TRAC reports. [See More](#).
